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

Introduction

Also known as MiaoQian Bing Shi, Hope & Sesame is the first speakeasy cocktail bar in Guangzhou. Tucked away behind a traditional Cantonese cafe in the quaint neighbourhood of Dongshan Kou, the bar is a unique testing ground for cocktail innovation. From liquid clarification and exploration of different ices to sous-vide infusions and distillation, guest will discover a wide repertoire of techniques that ultimately perfect the drink. Behind another secret door within Hope & Sesame, there is the iconic "The Jazz Room," a salon with passionate jazz players congregating nightly to perform lively tunes, and a true sanctuary even for the most discerned jazz enthusiasts. Its menu Five Years of Hope draws on the bar's

most-popular drinks since its launch. From 2016, look out for From Pablo, which features saffron-infused Mancino Rosso, pisco-infused raisins and bitters. For something a little harder, look to 2018 and Spicy Not Spicy, which uses chilli-infused rum, passion fruit, amaro and lime.

Introduction

An antique architectural complex on the northeast side of Haizhu lake - the new venue of the Guangzhou Cultural Center which will be put into use soon. Situated at the southern end of the city's central axis, this venue was designed as a Lingnan-style garden. The buildings are scattered around the Haizhu lake like stones and assembled into various courtyards, forming a layout of "a garden within a garden". Meanwhile, the typical landscape elements of the Lingnan region, "mountains, rivers, fields, and ponds", are integrated into the design of the venue.

Furthermore, the center integrates public performances, training, exhibitions, creation, research and exchanges, protection and inheritance of intangible cultural heritage, and other functions, which will become a landmark of Guangzhou.

The first phase of the wetlands is a combination of wetland scenery and Lingnan waterside town culture with characteristic Lingnan arches and ear houses. The second stage focuses on the original wetland ecology, creating a bird paradise on the foundation of the original orchard.

Guangdong Museum is a first-rate provincial museum in China, containing 166,000 items, including calligraphy, paintings, ceramics, woodcarvings, and gemstones. Covering an area of 67,000 square meters (721,182 square feet) in Tianhe District Guangzhou, it looks like a jewel box from the outside with five floors above ground and one floor below. There are five permanent exhibitions in the museum: Guangdong History and Culture, Chaozhou Gilded Woodcarvings, Natural Resources, Ceramics, and Duan Inkstones.

Introduction

Kuivuan is one of the five overseas Chinese gardens. It was built by Ma Zhuowen, an American overseas Chinese. It was built in 1922. The building is well-preserved, and it also maintains the previous red brick structure. When the Third National Congress of the Communist Party of China was going to be held at that time, a particularly inconspicuous hut was chosen. The representatives who came to Guangzhou used this building with the obvious 1922 as a reference and contact, so it gave Kuiyuan a special meaning. Kuiyuan has now been rented by several young people and opened as an art gallery. The first floor is a gallery, which holds some exhibitions from time to time, and the second floor is a high-end furniture store.


Introduction


